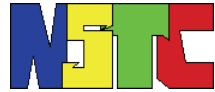

Strategic Plan:

- ◆ **Increase awareness of process industry careers and provide guidance along industry career paths in both urban and rural Alaska through:**
 - Coordination of TIE, Career Fairs, STeP and Career Awareness Workshops annually.
- ◆ **Advocate to provide CTE opportunities for students who do not have access to them.**
